




New councillor co-opted

... and Pillbox history information wanted



Eden Valley Museum is looking for any information local people may have about the network of pillboxes that runs through the Eden Valley, and who manned these World War Two defensive structures. Pillboxes can be found along the line of the River Eden and Hever Castle lakes. They were most likely part of the 'Ironside line' named for the General that ordered their construction. The Eden Valley section was part of a line that ran up from Newhaven across to Penshurst. They were intended to form a substantial anti-tank obstacle along the Eden and Medway but were superseded by a more mobile defence plan adopted in August/September of 1940.

The Museum would like to find out anything about the garrisons of these emplacements, most likely manned by Local Defence Volunteer (LDV)/Home Guard units. Draft Policies in Neighbourhood Plan survey
