
## **Facelift for the High Street**

Fixtures and fittings along the High Street have been given a facelift with the black and gold paint colour scheme renewed. The suite of street furnishing installed during the refurbishment project in 2008 ranges from bins and bollards to benches, planters, and finger-post signs.

A window of fine weather meant the work was completed in a week. It is part of the Council's new 10-year maintenance plan for all of the open spaces items for which it is responsible—from parks and playgrounds, to the cemetery, allotments, and sports fields.

This is a rolling programme of activity spread over the next decade to continue a high standard of maintenance. The Council's four playgrounds have been repainted, and the skate ramps facility at Blossoms Park is due replacement riding surface in the autumn. Sections

of the paths in Stangrove Park are being resurfaced, and surveys carried out of the pond there and at Mowshurst, to prepare a plan for managing the environment round these water features.

## **Neighbourhood Plan** policies questionnaire



Local residents have broadly supported first drafts of local planning policies for the Neigh-Neighbourhood Plan, covering

housing, design, environment, economy, infrastructure, and health/learning/wellbeing. But the majority of replies came from the over-60s, so to get a balance across the wider community the project group is now targeting younger age groups at family events across the summer, particularly to gather views on possible future housing provision. 
