8. PLANNING BUSINESS

8.1 Planning application 17/03545/FUL

The above application for The Coach House Swan Lane Edenbridge KENT TN8 6AJ (Demolition of existing dwelling; erection of replacement dwelling and single storey garage and associated works) is due to be considered at the meeting of the Development Control Committee, at SDC, on 22 February. It has been called in by Cllr J Scholey – Cllr S McGregor will be representing the Town Council.

Previously members supported the application, provided adequate drainage was included to counter the impervious area of the original dwelling, and that the original dwelling was knocked down in good time.

8.4 Action with Communities in Rural Kent – community-led housing

Action with Communities in Rural Kent is holding a free event on 9 March, to explore how community-led housing can provide communities with the opportunity to create the type of housing they need, including permanently affordable housing and homes for older residents – description below. Unfortunately, this has proved extremely popular and has already sold out, but there’s a possibility they may hold another one.

Which members wish to go if another one is arranged?

“Action with Communities in Rural Kent is delighted to announce the formation of Community Led Housing, West Kent. It’s a new service empowering communities to develop and manage their own housing projects, and to increase the quality and supply of community-led, affordable housing in West Kent.

Community-led housing is developed and managed by local people to maximise community benefits such as local affordability and good design – people and

communities play a key role in addressing their own housing needs. It includes Community Land Trusts (CLTs), Co-Housing, Co-Operative Housing and Self-Build.

We'd like to invite you to come along to find out more about community-led housing. The project is supported by Sevenoaks District Council, Tunbridge Wells Borough Council, Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council and the Community Housing Fund allocated to them by the government in 2017.

We'll have expert speakers (CLTs, Cohousing, Neighbourhood Plans), engaging case studies, Q&A sessions and networking. The Institute Hall is a 5 minute walk from East Malling station, there is free parking behind the hall and low cost payment parking off the High Street, a short walk away. The hall's car park is via the King and Queen pub's car park next door which also serves great food if you'd like to eat beforehand (booking advisable). Reserve your free place now and we'll look forward to seeing you then."

9. TRANSPORT BUSINESS

9.1 Road issues

9.1.1 Parking group meeting

The parking group met on 16 February to discuss electric charging points, 20mph traffic calming in the High Street, wayfinder signs, Market Yard car park entrance, parking in Station Approach, additional areas of land for parking, and received an update on the meeting last year with KHS officers. A report will come to the committee shortly.

A resident has written to ask if the Council has considered putting in traffic calming measures in Stangrove Road. Having lived in the road for 10 years, he has seen traffic gradually increase speed to the point where he now believes it is dangerous. He believes it is particularly bad at the traffic lights end of the road where people drive faster to beat the changing lights.

How do members wish to respond to his request?

9.1.2 Electric charging points in Market Yard car park

At last month's Planning meeting a request was made for electric charging points to be installed in the town. The committee clerk has started enquiries and is to investigate further, in particular finding out about metering; contacting Charge Your Car; looking at possible locations, including the two train stations, Lidl and the Leisure Centre; and feeding into the Stangrove Park consultation.

9.1.3 Park Avenue verge

An update on the Park Avenue verge has been received. Historically, there have been complaints about damage to it, with the kerbs and verge constantly being overrun, mostly by dust carts and larger delivery vehicles. Kent Highways have made plans to make the area safer by lowering the kerbs, removing up to 1.2m of verge, and then putting in a new kerb line at the rear to protect the rest of the verge. These works are being done for safety and access/maintenance purposes and will not impact on current plans under consultation by SDC.

UPDATE FROM GTR

Andy Leister is moving to another area, Nkulu will be the Area Manager. East Grinstead will have a half hour Sunday service. Uckfield will have an earlier Sunday service.

Officer's report:

Sharon went through her recent actions and this demonstrated excellent progress against the 2017 action plan.

Sharon asked the group for input for the 2018 Action Plan Action All to consider and contact Sharon with ideas.

Sharon confirmed the Line Guide was due for review and asked the steering group whether to update or re-write the joint lines guide, the group suggested update. To include a section on the Heritage Railways and how to get to them. **Action Sharon.**

Sharon confirmed that Christmas trees have been going up at the stations .

John Coleman: Station Travel Plans – how much consultation has there been? Is Bluebell mentioned? The Plans include details of the consultations carried by the consultants retained by GTR.

Sharon confirmed the joint the annual meeting will be held in the morning on 26 October at the same venue the Eden Centre, Edenbridge

Proposed speakers include Speakers – Roger Blake Railfuture, Paul Best NR, Brian Hart BML2 or Uckfield Lewes line. Action Sharon to arrange

John Coleman: The timetable for completion of the study for BML2/Wealden line is next Spring/April. He had attended a presentation on the project, towns along the line were in favour, the smaller parishes not so much.

John Phillips: Isfield has raised objections.

Mark Robson: There is finally interest from Kent in the scheme.

Bob Howes: Same concerns from smaller stations ie: Hever.

Jackie: There would be a two-way travel benefit.

John Coleman: Gibb report states the present rate of cancellations is bound to get worse.

PARTNERS UPDATE:

John Fowden: The Community Rail consultation from the DfT is very positive.

Tim Barkley: The next Director/staff workshop will be considering the t the consultation which has been circulated to all the steering groups. Partners are invited to respond direct to DfT and to advise Sharon of any matters they consider the SCRP should include in its own response. Action All

Bob Howes: Advised the Edenbridge Town station is still closed due to staff sickness. He also stated that the ticket machine doesn't issue off peak tickets early enough. ACTION: Sharon to follow up with Donna and request a response from GTR.

The same problem applied to the ticket machine at Uckfield which hasn't worked for weeks ACTION: Sharon to follow up with Donna and request a response from GTR

Paul Best: Network Rail has been devolved into smaller areas. New Business Development Managers want to tap into developers 106 monies from local authorities.

Future planning, System operation. Traffic management through Thameslink core. Incident planning.

APACO car parking firm praised for community involvement at Uckfield.

Car-parking: Possible two new platforms at East Croydon, NR kept space for installation..

John Fowden: Asked if later trains (after midnight) from Victoria and London Bridge change the planned maintenance?

John Phillips: The next Tonbridge line steering group meeting will be held on 30 January. Also he is concerned about the Tonbridge – Redhill service being changed to a shuttle.

Mark Robson: Nothing to add.

Jackie Downing: URLPC welcomes new Sunday timetable. They want to set-up a partnership to deal with parking issues. The current service is patchy they are writing to the MP to take the issue to the DfT. On-going problems with the ticket machines. Upholstery on train seats – are cleaning standards slipping? The new Area Manager is to attend URLPC meetings.

Transport for the Southeast is a new group being formed (see the website) promoted by East Sussex County Council.

Tim Barkley: I understand that the URPLC have asked Roger Blake and Tim Sparrow to investigate parking issues.

John Coleman: Crowborough Town Council and Councillors are disappointed with the service and ticket machines that are not working correctly. Plus there is now signage for 'on train' purchase which is not good enough for promoting off peak travel. Passengers are being mistreated at the end of their journey if they have been unable to purchase a ticket. The Council will contact the MP Nus Ghani and will also write to the Lewes MP to support the Lewes extension.

The Bluebell report will be attached

John Carvey: Has had no problems with travel.

Tim Barkley: SCRP news, new staff for Seaford Line via Active Access/East Sussex CC fund. Also a new Officer for the North Downs Line. There will be a Director/Staff workshop in December.
