Come and see High Street improvement proposals

Local people are invited to come and see a display on proposals for improvements to the High Street. Town Councillors will be on hand at the event to answer questions on Saturday 12th May. It will run from 10am until 2pm in Doggetts Barn, the Town Council office.

The proposals include a possible 20mph zone in the High Street, re-opening a one-way entrance into the Market Yard car park, and a series of new "wayfinder" signs to link the different sections of the town centre and encourage visitors to walk between them.

A feasibility study has been carried out, with a grant from Kent County Councillor Peter Lake's members' funding. Now the Town Council is keen to hear what local people think of the ideas.

Neighbourhood Plan on hold

Work on the Edenbridge Neighbourhood Plan is currently "on 1 hold", while Sevenoaks Edenbridge District Council is pre-



paring a new version of its own district-wide Local Plan. bridge had sent SDC the first draft of its own policies for future housing, design, environment, econoinfrastructure, and health/ my, learning/well-being for the Neighbourhood Plan — but these have to fit in with District policies (and National Planning Policy Framework, which the Government is also reviewing now).

It is likely to be the Autumn before the higher level Plans are set, and the Edenbridge Neighbourhood Plan can then be reviewed against them, and its policies possibly then amended.

The Neighbourhood project has involved groups of volunteers and local organisations, as well as councillors gathering evidence to support the policies.

Iron Age Treasure unveiled

Discovered in a Kentish field, a rare hoard of 10 small gold coins found by a detectorist are now on display in the Eden Valley Museum. They were minted by the Am-Gaul (Northern biani tribe in France and Belgium) around 60-50 BC and are "staters" which were used to forge alliances, and as gifts to mercenaries—at a time
